## Minutes of the Annual General Meeting of the Australasian Society for Breast Disease held on Saturday 10 July 2010 at The Langham Auckland

### 2. Minutes from the last Annual General Meeting

Robin Stuart-Harris tabled the minutes from the previous Annual General Meeting, held on 3 October 2009 on the Gold Coast. Acceptance of the minutes as a true record of that meeting was moved by Kerry McMahon and seconded by Roslyn Drummond. The motion was carried.

### 3. Business arising from the minutes

#### *Website re-development*

Robin Stuart-Harris explained that the Society's website has a special 'members only' section through which on-line access to *The Breast* can be obtained. Currently, the username for the members' section remains as senology and password as asbd97. For access to *The Breast* you need your personal Elsevier code (on wrapper of the hardcopy journal but can also be obtained from Solei Gibbs). As mentioned at the last Annual General Meeting, members will be notified of the new username and password once the new database is completed. The plan is to have a facility for on-line renewal of membership subscription, including individual usernames. However, due to some unforeseen issues, the development of the new web-based database development and associated facilities has been delayed. It will finally be launched later this year. As from next year, a two-tiered membership will be offered. One level will remain the same as now – including both hardcopy of *The Breast* as well as on-line access, the other will include on-line access only. The second option will naturally have a lower fee.

Currently, the members' section includes documents such as minutes from previous annual general meetings and the Society's Articles of Association. Robin welcomed members' feedback and suggestions for the website. He also asked members to forward details of various relevant conferences to Solei to include on website links.

#### *Membership recruitment*

Robin Stuart-Harris reported that during the year, the Executive Committee continued to promote the Society and the "Looking to the Future Meeting" via advertisements in Medical Oncology Group and Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Radiologists (RANZCR) newsletters and the *Pathology* journal, and recently via *Cancer Review*, as well as via mail outs through the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons' Breast Section. The Executive are also targeting relevant individuals for joining the Society. He said work will continue on ways to target some groups, especially medical and radiation oncologists to join the Society and to attend the Society's Meetings.

Robin said that the decision to hold the "Looking to the Future Meeting" in New Zealand was made with the aim to raise the Society's profile in this country. To date, some half a dozen new members from New Zealand have been gained as a result but, hopefully, there will be longer term benefits in this area in the future.

#### **2010 Meeting**

Robin Stuart-Harris said that the "Looking to the Future Meeting" is held in conjunction with the Auckland Breast Cancer Study Group. However, ASBD undertook to carry the full financial responsibility for the Meeting. It has been a challenging Meeting for all concerned. For example, until two weeks ago a substantial financial loss was feared and Kerry McMahon will mention more about this in her Treasurer's Report.

He said that this is a very different Meeting to ones the Society has held before, with multiple concurrent workshops, so it will be interesting to receive feedback on how well the program is received. It was organised with Belinda Scott, Reena Ramsaroop and Bruno Giuffre as main convenors with input from Robin and, of course, Solei Gibbs. Robin thanked everyone for their efforts, as well as the various people involved in the organisation of some particular aspects, especially Daniel de Viana, Warwick Lee, Sue Fraser and Barbara Hochstein.

#### **2011 Meeting**

Robin Stuart-Harris said that the Society's Eighth Scientific Meeting will be held in Melbourne 6-8 October 2011. This decision was confirmed at the last Annual General Meeting, when the reasons behind it were also explained. The decision was not taken lightly. The Executive Committee had long term debates about issues such as clashing with the RANZCR Annual Meeting. In the end, the final decision to go ahead was made. The recently printed announcement flier is now available. He said the Executive are very excited about the distinguished line up of international speakers: Christiane Kuhl (radiologist from Bonn), Krishna Clough (oncologic surgeon from Paris), Lawrence Solin (radiation oncologist from Philadelphia) and Ian Smith (medical oncologist from London). Meeting co-convenors are Jacqueline Chirgwin, Wendy Raymond, Roslyn Drummond, Kerry McMahon, Daniel de Viana and Robin. The convenors are already well advanced in respect to developing the program. Robin urged as many members as possible to attend.

### **4. Reports**

#### ***President's report***

Robin Stuart-Harris reported that during 2009, the Executive Committee held six meetings, four of which were held via teleconference. Further meetings have been held to date this year and in late August the Executive will have another strategic planning meeting in Sydney. Apart from these meetings, numerous subcommittee meetings were held in regard to both the 2010 and 2011 Meetings.

At the 2009 Annual General Meeting, the Society had 262 financial members (225 in 2008, 214 in 2007); since, further members have joined with the total as 286 by June 2010. As membership notices went out late this year, due to database development issues, only a percentage of members have renewed their membership to date (184). Membership subscriptions renewals traditionally continue to arrive well until the end of the year, sometimes even beyond. The Society has gained some six new members recently (before this Meeting) from New Zealand. Hopefully, many more will join. Robin asked for members to tell their New Zealand colleagues who attended the Meeting that if they join during the Meeting, or even within a three week or so period they will be entitled to a member registration fee (and thus, receive a substantial discount on their membership in return).

Robin said 309 people had registered for the Meeting, including approximately 55 surgeons, 51 radiologists and 25 pathologists.

#### ***Treasurer's report***

Robin Stuart-Harris invited Kerry McMahon to present the Treasurer's report.

Kerry was pleased to report that the Society's account on 31 December 2009 showed a positive balance of \$300,269.



In 2009, the Society had an operating profit of \$38,300. This was up from \$6,694 in the previous year due to the Scientific Meeting being held in 2009. Apart from the Meeting, other income in 2009 was derived from membership fees and bank interest on term deposit.

The Society's financial year runs from 1 January to 31 December and some copies of the Auditor's Report are available for any member wishing to peruse them. As the Annual General Meeting is held in the second half of the calendar year, Kerry said she would present an interim profit and loss statement / balance sheet to 28 June 2010 with the Treasurer's report.

On 28 June 2010, the Society's net assets stood at \$315,207. Much of the income from the "Looking to the Future Meeting" is included in the figures but there are a number of expenditure items yet to be paid for.

Kerry reported that until some 10 days ago the Executive were expecting a substantial financial loss; however, due to further registration influx the budget has improved. Nevertheless, she said there are expenditure items that cannot be reported on at this stage, like some of the social function expenditure and, thus, it is not possible to predict whether the Meeting will break even or carry some financial loss.

Acceptance of the Treasurer's report's was moved by Daniel de Viana and seconded by Wendy Raymond. The motion was carried.

#### ***Auditor's report and appointment***

Kerry McMahon referred to the Auditor's report which is available for members to see. Acceptance of the Auditor's report was moved by Kerry McMahon and seconded by Roslyn Drummond. The appointment of Griffin Carr as the Society's Auditors was moved by Kerry McMahon and seconded by Roslyn Drummond.

### **5. Items of business**

#### ***Collaboration with Asian Breast Disease Societies***

Robin Stuart-Harris said the Executive plan to discuss a closer association between the Society and the Asian Breast Disease Association, for example, at the upcoming Strategic Planning Meeting. He welcomed any input and knowledge from members. He said the Executive would also welcome feedback on the possibility of a potential joint Scientific Meeting with Asian Societies.

### **6. Election of Executive membership**

Robin Stuart-Harris reported that the Executive Committee composition since the 2009 AGM has been: Robin Stuart-Harris (Medical Oncologist), President; Kerry McMahon (Radiologist), Secretary/Treasurer; Wendy Raymond (Pathologist), President-Elect; Natascha Borecky (Radiologist); Marie-Frances Burke (Radiation Oncologist); Roslyn Drummond (Radiation Oncologist); Susan Fraser (Breast Physician); Daniel de Viana (Surgeon); and Lynne Mann (Surgeon).

Co-opted members for the year have been ex-directors: Nehmat Houssami (Breast Physician & Medical Epidemiologist, James Kollias (Surgeon) and Warwick Lee (Radiologist). Other co-opted members have been Jacqueline Chirgwin (Medical Oncologist), Bruno Giuffre (Radiologist), Sunil Lakhani (Pathologist), Julia Leeds (BCNA Representative) and Belinda Scott (Surgeon).

Nehmat Houssami, Warwick Lee and James Kollias will step down from the Executive this year altogether.

Robin welcomed James French (Surgeon) as the newly co-opted member to the Executive Committee.

The Society's Articles of Association state that the number of full Executive Committee members is nine. Thus, whilst eligible for re-election, three longest serving members are due to step down to co-opted level: Marie Burke, Lynne Mann and Natascha Borecky. Bruno Giuffre and Belinda Scott are up for election to the Executive as full Directors. Robin said he will step down as President and that Wendy Raymond has been in the role of President-Elect since the last Annual General Meeting.

Robin asked whether any members wanted to comment on this proposal. As no comments were made, this Executive Committee was duly elected.

On behalf of the Society, Robin thanked Nehmat Houssami, James Kollias and Warwick Lee for all their work over the many years. Nehmat and James had sent their apologies for the Meeting but Robin presented a memento to Warwick Lee for his valued time on the Executive, two of those years as President. Warwick thanked the Society for the time he had been given to serve a role and said this has been one of the highlights of his career. He encouraged other members to also get more involved with the Society.

Robin finally thanked all the Executive Committee members for their work during the year and congratulated Wendy Raymond as new President.

#### **7. Other Business**

There was no other business to discuss.

#### **8. Next Annual General Meeting date**
