

ASBD TRAINEE SCHOLARSHIP

(1 awarded each ASBD Conference year) Value up to \$3315

The aim of the scholarship is to encourage trainees to submit high-quality presentations of their research.

Eligibility Criteria

- Trainee who is a current financial member of ASBD.
- Has not previously been awarded an ASBD Trainee Scholarship.

Application

Submission of an abstract (which may be considered for an oral or poster presentation). Eligible applicants should notify the annual meeting's organiser when submitting their title and abstract (so that they know you wish to be considered for the scholarship).

A cover letter should express the wish to be considered for the Trainee Scholarship, the name of the supervisor for the work and the role played by the applicant in the work presented.

A letter is required from the supervisor to confirm the trainee's role in the project. This can be submitted after the initial application but must be received by the organising committee prior to judging.

Decisions regarding abstract selection will be made by the organising committee based on the merit of the work presented and the contribution of the applicant to that work.

Judging

The Scholarship recipient will be decided by a panel of at least three judges who are on the ASBD Board. Supervisors of applicants cannot be judges. The successful applicant will be notified approximately two months prior to the ASBD Scientific Meeting to allow time for planning.

Value up to \$3,315

Scholarship Includes: A financial grant of up to \$2000 to cover costs including return economy airfares, accommodation at the Conference, transport to and from airports, incidental travel expenses including travel insurance; PLUS, provision of Conference and Workshop Registration as well as Welcome Drinks & Conference Dinner (on top of financial grant funding).
