

Terms and Conditions for ASBD Scholarships

1) Active ASBD Membership

a) Scholarship recipients are encouraged to maintain active membership with ASBD for a period of at least 3 years post Scholarship and within the correct membership category.

2) Continued Professional Engagement

a) Scholarship recipients will engage professionally in the field of breast care or related disciplines, and uphold current best practices in clinical, research, academic, or public health contexts.

3) Ethical Standards

a) Scholarship recipient's adherence to ASBD's Code of Conduct, as well as applicable institutional, regulatory, and ethical frameworks governing clinical practice, research, and professional behaviour.

4) Representation of the Society

a) Scholarship recipients are viewed as ambassadors of ASBD and are encouraged to uphold the Society's reputation and values in all professional, academic, and public forums, including digital platforms.

5) Reporting

- a) Successful applicants are required to submit a report to ASBD on Scholarship outcomes and impact
 - b) Overview of the scope of activity undertaken with the support of the ASBD Scholarship
 - c) Key outcomes and impact across any of the following areas:
 - i) How did the funding from this Scholarship contribute to your research project and/or career development?
 - ii) Would the outcomes have been possible without this funding? If not, what would have been different?
 - d) What would you say to future applicants about the importance of the received Scholarship?
- Scholarship recipients agree to ASBD promoting details of the Scholarship and outcomes across its membership, website, annual review and other social media forums.

6) Use and access to ASBD funds

- a) ASBD Scholarship funds are to be used for the ASBD Scientific Meeting immediately after application.
 - b) An extended term to use funds will apply to members with extenuating circumstances at the approval of the ASBD Board.
 - c) Following the Scholarship announcement, recipients will receive a confirmation letter congratulating their achievement and outlining the following:
 - i) The Scholarship details and scope
 - ii) Terms and conditions
 - iii) Confirmation of relevant banking details to enable payment via ASBD reimbursement form
 - iv) Supply of receipts for any reimbursements
- Scholarship recipients will be required to sign and return the letter confirming their understanding of ASBDs T&C prior to ASBD providing financial disbursement.

7) Contribution to ASBD - Leadership and Mentorship

- a) Where appropriate and mutually agreeable, recipients are encouraged to contribute to the advancement of ASBD's purpose by:
 - i) Participating in ASBD conferences, working groups, or committees.
 - ii) Provide testimonies in support of future applicants and for promotion of ASBD activities
 - iii) Supporting the development of early-career professionals through mentorship or collaboration
